Building Maintenance Course Syllabus

Course Description:

This course prepares the student for jobs in the Building Maintenance industry. The Building Maintenance industry is basically divided into two areas: the maintenance functions and custodial functions. Students will gain a thorough knowledge of the tools, materials, and equipment used in both sides of the industry. In addition the students will be schooled in all the trades dealing with the materials they will be tasked with maintaining in order to promote a thorough understanding of all the materials.

<u>Coarse Objectives:</u>

Students will become proficient in a broad range of diversified Building Maintenance skills. The areas covered will include commercial cleaning procedures to maintenance functions such as sanitizing, disinfecting, basic plumbing, carpentry, electricity, masonry, various forms of flooring, and grounds maintenance. There is great flexibility in the program to meet individual student needs for growth

Text & Open Source Materials:

Framing, Modern, Woodworking Modern Residential Wiring, Modern Carpentry, Plumbing Installation and Design

Many Open Source Materials are used to instruct; students are encouraged to research their individual and team projects using open source information

Required Materials:

- Students will be required to supply a spiral notebook and blue or black pens and number two pencils daily
- Students will supply a hard-soled work shoe for use while in the shop.
- Students will wear proper shop attire: long pants and long or short sleeved shirts.
- Students will be responsible for intentionally damaged tools and equipment.
- Students must wear approved safety glasses while in shop.
- Ear protection must be worn while machines are in use.
- Students will provide means to tie back long hair while in the shop.

Evaluation:

Students will be assigned homework, assignments, duties and tests during the marking period. Daily hands on performance tasks will be assigned.

Students will be graded on a combination of their mastery of the task as well as their effort.

20% Tests and Quizzes 20% Homework and Written Assignments 60% Shop Participation and Clean Up
