Please note:

- Completion of the summer assignment will count toward the student's classwork grade.
- Students will be assessed on these skills during the first week of class in September.

Optional Summer Practice

Students entering Algebra I College Prep, Geometry College Prep/Honors, or Algebra II College Prep are encouraged to complete an optional summer practice assignment. These are not required but are recommended for students who want to refresh their skills and feel confident entering the new school year.
