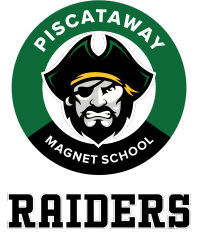

**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

In Spanish 2, you build upon the Spanish basic skills you already learned in Spanish I and will further develop your ability to communicate in the language.

**REQUIRED SUPPLIES**

**COURSE OVERVIEW AND OBJECTIVES**

- Marking Period 1: La Familia: Talk about family members and their relationship to each other, Introduce fam. members to a friend, describe fam. members.
- Marking Period 2: Pastimes: Talk about favorite pastimes and make plans, talk about and plan a vacation, express present tense activities
- Marking Period 3: De Compras: Talk about clothing/shopping preference, discuss clothing fit and price, exchange info. about activities that occurred in the past, exchange opinions about clothing items.
- Marking Period 4: La Rutina Diaria: Discuss daily routines, write an ad for a product or a store, Describe a personal experience of a place that you visited.

**CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS AND PROCEDURES**

- **Be Respectful** of yourself and others. Respect personal space and property. Use appropriate language for a classroom.
- **Be Prepared**-Bring all necessary materials and assignments.
- **Be Productive**- Be on task, listen with intent to understand, participate actively during activities, complete classwork during the time allotted. Stay in your seat unless directed otherwise by the teacher.
- **Leaving the Classroom**-You **may not** leave the classroom without notifying the teacher and without a proper pass. Please keep bathroom visits short and to a minimum. *The best time to use the restroom is before or after class.*
- **Dismissal**-Please stay in your seat until the bell rings and Señora Byszynski dismisses the class.
- **Academic Dishonesty**-Cheating and plagiarism will result in a grade of zero in the assignment, parent notification and any other disciplinary actions as stated in the Student Code of Conduct in the Student Handbook.
- Copying someone else's work, asking for or giving someone the answers for tests/quizzes/assignments **is cheating.**

Copying/pasting and printing information from a website to submit as your own work constitutes **plagiarism.**

Using Google Translate to translate your sentences or paragraphs is considered *cheating*.

- Your grades will go up or down depending on your performance in classwork, assessments, and class participation. You earn your grades with your hard work. Complete all work to the best of your ability and in a timely manner for the best grade possible.

#### MAKEUP WORK:

- If you are absent and you miss a quiz or an assessment, it is your responsibility to talk to me in order to schedule a make-up time within five days of your return. After that time the missing grade becomes a zero.
- You must make up all assignments you miss while absent within a reasonable amount of time. After your return to school, you will be allowed one day per each day of absence to complete the missing work.

#### LATE WORK POLICY:

- Assignments are *due on the due date*. Late homework or assignments will be deducted 1 point for each day they are late.

#### PARTICIPATION:

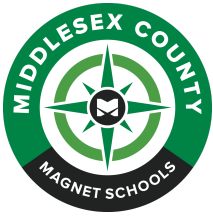
- *You will earn 27 Total points for participation at the end of each MP. Each week you will receive 3 points for participation. Depending on your level of participation, points will be deducted from the week's total.*
- Participation is expected of all students in Spanish class. In order to learn to speak a language it is necessary to practice and use what you have learned constantly. Spanish is the language that you are in this class to learn. To be successful, it is extremely important to speak the language *as much as possible*.
- Participation also means that you are engaged in the classroom activities **at all times**. This means that you are required to be on time to partake of all learning activities and to avoid distractions such as inappropriate use of electronic devices.

#### LATENESS TO CLASS:

- Please arrive on time to class. Unexcused lateness prevents you from fully participating in the learning process. As such, this will result in a loss of points from your weekly participation points. Repeated unexcused lateness to class will also result in parent notification (after 3 occurrences). Should lateness continue you will be referred to an administrator.

#### ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY:

- Per the Student Code of Conduct students **may not** use cellphones or earbuds/earphones during class unless directed by the teacher to do so to complete an educational activity. Inappropriate use of electronic devices presents a distraction that doesn't allow you to fully participate in class. As such, this will result in loss of points from your weekly participation grade.
