<u>Descubre 2</u>** Textbook ---- *Descubre 2 (textbook) will be used as a resource for vocabulary as well as some practice activities. Textbooks will remain in the classroom. Access to VHL/Descubre online Textbook will be available to all students.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM Instruction:

The "**<u>Stream (page)</u>**" on google classroom will be used for <u>announcements, reminders, and class</u> <u>information.</u> The <u>"Classwork (page)"</u> will provide all the different tabs with topics such as — <u>notes, vocabulary, tests, projects, resources, etc.</u> ** Check google classroom every day for any missed work, updates, and messages.

Assignments:

**Due dates and times for assignments/projects are not optional!

- 1. **VOCABULARY** Study the vocabulary as often as you can!
- **2.** <u>Classwork</u> Classwork Is to be completed within the time provided. Use your time efficiently.

Missing classwork will result in a zero. Class assignments will consist of written assignments, speaking assignments as well as listening and reading assignments regularly as we continue throughout the year.

3. <u>Homework</u> —Homework is to be completed by the due date. Missing homework will result in a zero.

4. Projects

- —There may be multiple project assignments within a marking period.
- —There will be in class project assignments as well as at home project assignments.
- -Project assignments are due by the due date! No exceptions!

5. Class Participation/Assignments

- Expect to receive **verbal and written** assignments regularly.
- Verbal use of the Spanish language is mandatory. Speaking is part of learning a language and will be required throughout many class assignments.
- You are expected to **participate and put forth effort** in class, as this is required to learn a language.
- It is your responsibility to get the notes and/or assignment and make up any missed work during an absence. Any missed work due to an absence must be completed within a timely manner (time discussed upon your return).
- *Assignments are to be <u>completed by the student</u>. Students will receive all the information necessary to complete all assignments.
- NO COMPUTER BASED TRANSLATION! Computer based translations will result in a grade reduction/a zero. Plagiarism will result in a failing grade and there will be no make-ups!

6. Tests and quizzes

- Expect unannounced quizzes.
- Expect **vocabulary drills** and vocabulary quizzes regularly.
- There will be a max of 2 tests throughout a marking period.
- Quizzes and tests must be made up on the new date discussed upon your return; otherwise it will go in as a zero.
- Tests will always be announced.

<u>****</u> At the end of the school year you will take the STAMP TEST. Information and instructions will follow throughout the school year.
