CHAPTER SELECTION PROCESS

Each spring the Edison Academy Chapter of the National Honor Society will induct a new class of members in an evening ceremony where family and friends are invited to celebrate.

The selection process for the National Honor Society is as follows:

- The Principal will identify potential junior year candidates in good academic standing and with a minimum unweighted GPAof 3.75 at the conclusion of the third marking period level to the National Honor Society advisers.
- The advisers will present the candidates with an application packet to be returned with supporting documents.
- The advisers will solicit the faculty feedback on each candidate. Once the advisers compile all the information, they will present it to the Faculty Council, five members who are appointed by the Principal.
- The Faculty Council will carefully consider each candidate according to the National Honor Society pillars of Character, Leadership, and Service, and cast a vote on her or his eligibility.
- At the conclusion of the selection meeting the advisers will present each candidate with a letter that states her or his induction status.
