
Full Time Students

Academic Information

The Academic program at MCVTS fulfills the New Jersey requirements for a State endorsed high school diploma

Students will take:

- 4 years of English
- 4 years of Physical Education/Health
- 3-4 years of Mathematics
- 3 years of History
- 3 years of Science
- 1-2 years of World Language
- 1 year of Financial Literacy

Depending on grade level, students receive anywhere from 1.5 - 3 hours of CTE each day

Transportation is provided by the Home district, for all students

The Career & Technical Education (CTE) Program

CTE Programs

CTE Career Majors are divided into two categories

- Mainstream
 - ☐ Class size may have 25+ students
 - **Comprised of students with and without special needs**
- Career Development
 - **■** Maximum class size is 15 students
 - All students are classified

CTE Structure

In September, 9th grade students rotate through five different Career Majors during the first marking period

- Each rotation lasts nine days
- Career Major instructors provide feedback on each student's experience in the class
- Students rate their experience and interest in each class
- Feedback from both the instructor and student are used to guide CTE placement

CTE Structure (Continued)

During the interview process, students are asked to choose five Career Majors, in order of preference.

Students are advised that their #1 Career Major choice cannot be guaranteed. Our goal is to place students in a Career Major that matches their interest and ability.

Academy Application

The Academy Application is now open until Wednesday, November 24th. Applicants must be in 8th grade and current residents of Middlesex County.

Middle school counselors will be required to submit student grades and other requested records.

MCVTS School Application

Students can apply to any of our East Brunswick, Perth Amboy, or Piscataway schools during 8th grade to begin as freshmen. Applications to the School of the Arts require an audition. Transfer applications will be considered based on availability for current 9th and 10th grade students. See the Schools link above for more information.

Career Choices Application - 8th grade program


Our Career Choices Program serves as a career diagnostic service for <u>8th</u> <u>grade level special education students</u>. Students have the opportunity to explore three major career clusters - Construction Technology, Digital Media Technology, and Food Health Technology - in rotations of six weeks each. Students who participate in the Career Choices Program are considered for early admissions into our high school program.
