

Course Syllabus: Personal Health and Chemical Health Education, 2022-23

Grade 11

Instructor – Ms. McNulty

The eleventh grade health component is divided into four broad sections: personal health, anatomy and physiology of body systems, mental and emotional health, and chemical health education. The information in these units will be woven together to explore the many aspects of the human body.

Students will participate in classroom activities and assignments designed to promote thought and discussion leading to comprehension of each of the topics addressed. Evaluation of student progress will be based on a combination of classroom participation (written and verbal), homework assignments, quizzes, tests and alternate assessment projects. Students will always be given advance notice of tests and alternate assessment projects. *Quizzes may not be announced.*

The marking level grade will be calculated based upon the following distribution of points: classroom participation and homework = 10%, quizzes = 40%, tests and alternate assessment projects = 50%.

All work is assigned a due date which is non-negotiable.

All written work will be completed in a neat and legible manner. It is expected that the majority of homework will be type-written. Assignments which are hand-written and not legible will not receive credit.

Students absent on a health day are responsible for; inquiring about assignments missed, submitting any assignments due and scheduling a make up date for assessments *upon the first day of return*. Any student who does not retrieve missed work or submit assignments due during an absence on the day of their return will received zero credit for said assignment. Assignments should not be sent electronically unless specifically instructed to do so.

When products are submitted via Google Classroom, it will be the Google timestamp that determines the timeliness of a submission.
